- Three Scholarships of \$1,000 in value each will be awarded to three different individuals.
- Applicants must be enrolled and attend a school in Mohave County, Grade 12 set to graduate in 2026. Verification of enrollment and official transcripts will be needed.
- GPA (Grade Point Average) must be 2.6 or higher.
- Applicants must use scholarship awards for a Trade School, Community College, College, or University. Funds must be applied toward tuition, fees, and other educational expenses within one calendar year.
- Applicants need not be a member of Mohave Community Federal Credit Union.
- Applicants must turn in an essay of 1500 words or less answering a supplemental question.
- Applicants must provide proper contact information: Name, Age, Address, Phone number, Email address, and name of school they are attending along with school's address, phone number and name of guidance counselor or dean of students.
- Applicants must also pass a FREE online course with Learning Lab by Green Path. <https://www.greenpath.com/learninglab/> and turn in the certificate of completion for the course A1 Credit Tool: Learn to Improve your Credit Regardless of your Starting Point.
- Entries for scholarships will begin February 1, 2026. Deadline for scholarships entries is 5:00pm Monday, April 20, 2026.
